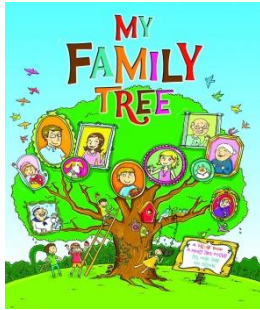


Homework Grid - Year 1 Autumn Term 2- My History

Choose **one** of the six homework ideas below to do as your Topic homework for this term.

1.

Make a family tree for as many generations of your family as you can. Be creative with your presentation in your homework book.



2.

Talk to a grandparent or an older relative, about what life was like for them when they were a child. What do they remember about: school, toys, community and home life? Write down what you find out.



3.

Find out how technology has changed since your parents / grandparents were born. You could look at phones, TV, radio, cars, computers etc Include pictures or drawings to show the changes.



4.

Create a poster of your life so far - like a timeline. Start from when you were a baby (include photos). How have you changed? What have you learnt to do? What events have happened in your life? Eg New baby, new house, holiday, ride a bike etc



5.

Find out about the history of your local area and how it might have changed in the past 70 years. You could use the internet to find old photos of the roads, parks and buildings as well as people. What differences can you see? You could draw pictures or print photos to stick into your books. Ask your family if they have seen any changes - even in the last 10 years.



6.

Research how fashion has changed, including clothes, shoes, hairstyles and accessories. Draw pictures or include photos of the differences. Ask family members about their favourite outfit when they were younger.
