## <u>Homework Grid – Year 6 Term 2 – World War One</u> Choose one of the six ideas below to do as your topic homework this term.

- 1. Create your own poppies using recycled materials you have at home. For example, you could make one from the end of a 2-litre bottle and paint the inside of the base red and black.
- 2. Listen to a song written around the time of the First World War. Search for: 'Pack Up Your Troubles', 'Keep the Home Fires Burning', or Gustav Holst's 'The Planets Suite: Mars' or 'Jupiter'. Write down how you feel when listening to them.
- 3. Research significant medals awarded during World War One. Create your own and explain why you have included what you have.



4. Research the uniform of a First World War soldier. Draw and label the key parts and explain why it was important soldiers wore a uniform.



5. Using everyday materials from home, create a trench scene from World War One. Find out the construction of trenches, what they were like and what life was like in the trench.



6. Learn about the use of recruitment posters during World War One and then create your own, persuading people to join the British Army.
